What's New:

Charge for After Hours - Non-Emergency Calls – September 1st 2024.

The District will re-institute its charge to customers for nonemergency service calls to a customer site. All service calls (like shut off and turn on) during <u>regular business</u> hours <u>will not be charged</u>.

The District pays for operators to be on call for emergencies, if there is an emergency, they can respond. As per the Clear Creek 2016 Rules and Regulations for Water service and the most recent fee ordinance (2020-14) - if the call is for a shut off/on or non-emergency; during non-business hours, the <u>customer will be billed</u> for the call out. The current Charge is \$100 and will be on the customer next bill.

Full Water Allocation – Rates Report:

Reminder: The Base rate is \$58.20 (Changed for this Bill) plus <u>water usage and</u> fees. Make sure to pay on time - A Late Fee of 1.5% will be applied to accounts who have not paid their bill by the 20th of each month. The District sent hundreds of delinquents and shut off notices (60 days plus late in payments) – with hundreds making payments or getting payment assistance. If you need payment assistance – The LIWHAP program is suspended by the state, we can offer payment plans. Call or email the office to find out more information.
