## Drought Restrictions & Penalties

Please be aware that penalties are in place for water over usage. The State and Bureau still consider us in Drought. You are allotted 75 % of your 2019 monthly usage **OR** 40 units / HCF whichever is **greater**.

The **Board** recognized we are in Winter conditions, and voted to **waive the penalties** this month. If you go over your allotment, you will still be notified.

**\*1 unit / HCF = 748 gallons\***

Reminder of the Penalties schedule:

< 5 HCF	\$50
5.1 - 10 HCF	\$100
10.1 - 20 HCF	\$400
20.1 - 50 HCF	\$600
50.1 - 100 HCF	\$800
<b>&gt;100 HCF</b>	<b>\$1,500</b>

### **Attention all Ag customers,**

We still need your annual crop reports. We understand that it seems like a waste of time, but we need to fill these out as if we received agricultural water to ensure our future needs for ag water in our community from the Bureau of Reclamation. We hope that things will turn around with our rainfall in future years.
