Community Input requested: The Western Shasta RCD is looking for input on the development of a "Community Wildfire Protection Plan" (CWPP) and hosting a community meeting November 7<sup>th</sup> at 6:30pm at the Happy Valley Community Center. Hear about current conditions and potential projects and provide your input about the area and potential projects. The District had a few leaks and repairs on Flowers Lane and on China Gulch. The Staff worked hard to get service restored and it has come to our attention that some customers have old/aging pressure release valves on their property. We strongly advise checking your pressure release valves – especially if they are 10 years or older. Replace them if they need to be replaced!

The District has had multiple calls from Customers to turn off their water for a repair. Do not tamper with the Meter or curb stop – if damaged, the Customer will be billed for the replacement and repair. We also encourage all customers to have a valve on their side of the Meter – Reminder: The District re-instituted charges to customers for non-emergency service calls to a customer site. All service calls (like shut off and turn on) during regular business hours will not be charged.

### **General Manager Note:**

The Happy Valley Farmers Market – Completed its first year. Thanks to those who volunteered and those who supported the Market. The Ag Committee and volunteers are looking to have a meeting early next year to plan for a good 2025.

Grant Project update: The Grant funded Treatment Plant Backwash ponds project has been moving along and the Pond 3 liner has had much of the concrete poured. It's still on schedule for the pond to be completed in November and tested. Then in the Spring of next year, Pond 2 will have a similar project and improvement. The slow reimbursement timelines from CalOES/FEMA and State has the District using Grant Anticipation loan financing with the support of the State Fee on Customer bills.

**Full Water Allocation – Rates Report:**

**Reminder: The Base rate is \$58.20 plus water usage and fees.** Make sure to pay on time - A **Late Fee** of **1.5%** will be applied to accounts who have not paid their bill by **the 20th of each month**. The District sent hundreds of delinquents and shut off notices (60 days plus late in payments) – with hundreds making payments or getting payment assistance. **If you need payment assistance** – we can offer payment plans.
